Winter Flying is here, Jim Eyre has posted some very valuable information on <u>Cold Weather</u> <u>Operations</u> (www.t-craft.org/Reference/ColdWXOps.pdf). This article is a very good refresher, and for the new pilot dealing with winter for the first time.

If you fly 375, please do a mag check just before shutdown, this way if the lower plugs are fowled, Jim Eyre can be contacted BEFORE the next scheduled flight.

**REMEMBER:** We are all owners of these aircraft, in the winter months, it takes longer to warm up the oil. Take a few extra minutes to warm up the oil before doing a run-up. It only takes a minute, and it saves possible damage and extra wear on the aircraft.

Winter Flying Hours are in effect December, January and February. You may fly all three of your use it or lose it hours in one month, or any combination of these three months.

USE TACH TIME FOR SQUAWKS PLEASE. This helps the maintenance team tremendously!

The sign-out sheets have not changed. Continue to use HOBBS Time for sign out sheets. This will continue to be the way you are billed.

Please "do the math" on your fuel reimbursements. It is very simple: take the number of gallons times the price per gallon listed on each month's newsletter. Write your name on the receipt with the total amount to be reimbursed.
